NUMBER OF POSITIONS AVAILABLE: One (1) – Location preference required.

DUTIES: Under the supervision of the Director, Division of Consumer Affairs, and the Director, Office of Communications for the Office of the Attorney General, or other supervisory official within the Department of Law and Public Safety ("Department"): is responsible for assigned work programs of the Division of Consumer Affairs ("Division"); develops and writes speeches, briefings, and other communications for the Division; translates the ideas, objectives, mission, and philosophy of the Division into written statements that relate to the assigned topic, speaker, and intended audience; performs outreach and communicates directly with members of the press; may supervise various Division outreach efforts; may compose editorials, press releases, articles and/or educational materials representing the Division, Department and/or Attorney General; may assist the Attorney General's Executive Staff and Division with speech delivery preparations, press conferences and other projects; will work independently and collaboratively within the Office of Public Communications; and performs other related work as required. This position may also require non-traditional work hours, on an as needed basis, including evenings and weekends on short deadlines for certain assignments, with or without advance notice, and may require travel to perform the aforementioned responsibilities.

REQUIREMENTS

EDUCATION: Graduation from an accredited college or university with a Bachelor's degree.

EXPERIENCE: Five (5) years of experience in the collection, analysis, preparation, and dissemination of information in a public relations and/or public information program in a public or private agency or organization, two (2) years of which shall have been in a supervisory capacity.

<u>NOTE</u>: Additional experience as indicated above may be substituted on a year-for-year basis for the above education. Thirty (30) semester hour credits are equal to one (1) year of experience.

<u>NOTE</u>: A Master's degree in Journalism, Public Relations, Communications, or English may be substituted for one (1) year of nonsupervisory experience.

PREFERENCE: Preference will be given to applicants with extensive journalism or public relations experience.

LICENSE: Appointees will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey.

<u>RESUME NOTE</u>: Eligibility determinations will be based upon information presented in resume only.
