DUTIES: Under the supervision of a supervisory official at the Northern Region Independence & Reentry Success Center, trains residents in the areas of food preparation, cooking, baking, meat cutting, pot washing, dishwashing, and the serving of food with emphasis upon the vocational training of residents and the maintenance of adequate production standards; does related duties.

REQUIREMENTS
