DUTIES: Under the direction of the Deputy Director or other supervisory official in the Office of the Director, Division of Consumer Affairs, will prepare agendas, including all relevant materials, for monthly meetings of the Board or Unit, as well as for Board or Unit committee and subcommittee meetings and prepares minutes of those meetings; coordinates and schedules formal and informal hearings; administers, oversees or coordinates testing of candidates for licensure; oversees the application process for licensure and issues licenses to qualified individuals; manages the staff of the Board or Unit; responds to written, electronic or telephone inquiries and complaints; collects data (statistical and financial) and prepares reports required and/or requested by the Department, Division, Board, Unit, other State Agencies or other stakeholders; maintains all Board or Unit records and files, including licensing and examination files, rules and regulations, continuing education material, and all legal resource material; executes Board or Unit decisions and policies, and executes Board or Unit policies as required; performs other related duties as assigned.

REQUIREMENTS

EDUCATION: Graduation from an accredited college or university with a Bachelor's degree.

EXPERIENCE: Five (5) years of comprehensive involving governmental or business administration, two (2) years of which shall be in a supervisory capacity.

NOTE: Applicants who do not possess the required education may substitute experience as indicated on a year for year basis, for the non-supervising experience.

LICENSE: Appointees will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle, rather than employee mobility, is necessary to perform the essential duties of the position.

PREFERENCE: Preference will be given to candidates with education and/or experience in mental health and/or mental health program administration.

All offers of employment are conditional subject to the applicant agreeing to and then passing a background check that may include fingerprinting.
