REQUIREMENTS

EDUCATION/EXPERIENCE:

Six (6) years of experience in weights and measures inspection, Investigative enforcement, two (2) years of which shall have included supervisory experience.

Thirty semester hours of college level study in the fields of engineering, physics, electronics, mathematics or statistical methods may be substituted for the required non-supervisory experience on a year for year basis, up to and including the first three years.
