DUTIES: Under the general supervision of a Supply Support Technician 2 or other supervisor in the Juvenile Justice Commission, assists with work involved in shipping, receiving, transporting, storage, stock rotation, pulling, checking, loading of trucks for delivery of supplies and materials in warehouse, distribution center, maintenance service area, or other complex installation with similar operations; does related work as required.

REQUIREMENTS

EXPERIENCE: One (1) year of experience in shipping and receiving work in a warehouse, distribution center, maintenance service area or other similar installation.

LICENSE: Appointee will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle, rather than employee mobility, is necessary to perform the essential duties of the position.

SPECIAL NOTE: Appointment to this title may be made provisionally, pending the outcome of an open-competitive examination (PAOC). If selected for the position and appointed PAOC, you will be required to apply for the open-competitive examination, when issued by the Civil Service Commission for this title, pass and be reachable on the resulting certification list to become permanent in the position. Appointees who fail to be reachable on the resulting CSC certification list are subject to removal.

RESUME NOTE: Eligibility determinations will be based upon information presented in resume only. Applicants who possess foreign degrees (degrees earned outside of the U.S.) are required to provide an evaluation indicating the U.S. equivalency prior to the closing date. Failure to do so may result in your ineligibility.
