DUTIES: Under the direction of the Supervisor of Educational Programs or Assistant Supervisor of Educational Programs, plans, executes, and evaluates the lessons and educational experiences of the assigned pupils, class, or classes. Performs these duties exercising independent judgement and with a comprehensive knowledge of department rules, regulations, and policies; does other related duties as required.

REQUIREMENTS

EDUCATION: Possession of a valid New Jersey Teacher's Certification (Standard, Certificate of Eligibility with Advanced Standing, or Certificate of Eligibility) issued by the Board of Examiners of the New Jersey Department of Education, authorizing instruction in the following subject areas: **Math, or PE/Health.**

EXPERIENCE (Teacher 3 only): Thirty-six (36) months of full-time, properly certified teaching experience in an approved school, earned after the receipt of a New Jersey Standard Teacher's Certification.

LICENSE: Appointee will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey.

RESUME NOTE: Eligibility determinations will only be based upon information presented in the resume. Applicants who possess foreign degrees (degrees earned outside of the U.S.) are required to provide an evaluation indicating the U.S. equivalency prior to the closing date. Failure to do so may result in your ineligibility.
