<u>**DUTIES:**</u> Under the direction of the Assistant Director, Juvenile Justice Commission, (JJC) Juvenile Parole & Transitional Services, or other supervisory official, is responsible for management of primary level supervisors and the parole/support staff that are responsible for planning, organizing and coordinating activities of youth in both JJC facilities and the community through various JJC services; performs related managerial assignments as required.

REQUIREMENTS

EDUCATION: Graduation from an accredited college or university with a Bachelor's degree.

EXPERIENCE: Five (5) years of experience in the field of juvenile justice, or in a program having responsibility to analyze, develop or implement social, community, or youth services, two (2) years of which shall have been in a supervisory capacity.

<u>NOTE</u>: Applicants who do not possess the required education may substitute additional experience as indicated above on a year- for-year basis.

<u>NOTE</u>: A Master's degree in Sociology, Psychology, Social Work, Education, Guidance, Counseling, Criminology, Criminal Justice or Public Administration may be substituted for one (1) year of the nonsupervisory experience.

<u>LICENSE</u>: Appointee will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle, rather than employee mobility, is necessary to perform the essential duties of the position.

RESUME NOTE: Eligibility determinations will be based upon information presented in resume only. Applicants who possess foreign degrees (degrees earned outside of the U.S.) are required to provide an evaluation indicating the U.S. equivalency prior to the closing date. Failure to do so may result in your ineligibility.
