<u>DUTIES</u>: Under the supervision of the Section Chief, the Assistant Section Chief assists with assigning and supervising the work of other deputies in the Section; assists the Section Chief in managing the deputies and other staff; assists with planning and managing the operations of the Section; evaluates the performance of deputies and conducts case file reviews; and performs other duties as required.

REQUIREMENTS

EDUCATION: Graduation from an accredited law school with a Juris Doctor. Admission to practice as an Attorneyat-Law in the State of New Jersey required.

EXPERIENCE: Four (4) years of experience as a practicing attorney, one (1) year of which shall have been in a supervisory capacity.

LICENSE: Appointee will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle, rather than employee mobility, is necessary to perform the essential duties of the position.

All offers of employment are conditional subject to the applicant agreeing to and then passing a background check that may include fingerprinting.
