<u>DUTIES:</u> Under direction of the Director, Office of Equal Employment Opportunity (EEO), or other supervisory official will be responsible for investigating complaints of discrimination; overseeing investigations; conducting interviews; reviewing investigation reports, researching relevant law and drafting EEO determination memoranda and letters regarding internal complaints of discrimination; will review intakes and determine how to proceed on each case; responsible for researching and developing training programs on specialized areas and will present those trainings and trainings on the State Anti-Discrimination Policy to all department staff including executive level staff, attorneys and supervisors; does other related work as required.

## REQUIREMENTS

**EDUCATION:** Graduation from an accredited law school with a Juris Doctor. Admission to practice as an Attorney at Law in the State of New Jersey is required.

#### **EXPERIENCE:**

DEPUTY ATTORNEY GENERAL 4: Two (2) years of experience as a practicing attorney. DEPUTY ATTORNEY GENERAL 3: Three (3) years of experience as a practicing attorney.

<u>LICENSE</u>: Appointee will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle, rather than employee mobility, is necessary to perform the essential duties of the position.

**SPECIAL NOTE:** Current Department employees appointed to a Deputy Attorney General 4 or 3 title must be willing to accept a lateral transfer, if selected.

**\*SALARY NOTE:** For newly hired individuals, the starting salary and title will be determined by the Department commensurate with experience. Salary offers and titles are non-negotiable and will fall within the range posted.

**PREFERENCE:** Preference will be given to attorneys who have excellent research, writing and analytical skills; knowledge of employment law and litigation experience is also desired.
