## NUMBER OF POSITIONS AVAILABLE: Two (2).

<u>DUTIES</u>: Under the direction of a supervisor in a State department or agency, as a trainee and productive worker, receives on the job training in analytic practices/procedures and application and research and preparation of reports, completes assignments which will provide practical analyst experience and/or learns to review and analyze financial reports; does other related work. ## **REQUIREMENTS**

**EDUCATION:** Graduation from an accredited college or university with a Bachelor's degree. Applicants must submit proof of Bachelor's degree completion to be considered. Therefore, one of the following items must be submitted together with a resume: (1) a copy of your college degree or (2) a copy of your final unofficial transcripts, which indicates the date your degree was conferred and the type of degree awarded. Failure to submit one of these two items, as aforementioned, will result in disqualification from consideration. Matriculating students cannot be considered.

**ADVANCEMENT:** Appointees who successfully complete the 12-month training period will be eligible for advancement to the following title: Fiscal Analyst. *The inability of an employee in this title to attain a level of performance warranting advancement to one of the titles listed above shall be considered as cause for separation.* 

<u>LICENSE</u>: Appointee will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle, rather than employee mobility, is required to perform the essential duties of the position.

**RESUME NOTE:** Eligibility determinations will be based upon proof of degree only. Failure to do so will result in your ineligibility.
