**DUTIES:** Under direction of a supervisory official within the New Jersey Racing Commission, conducts pre-race examinations of the horses to determine racing soundness, observes horses during the races and post-race, handles on-track emergencies, takes blood samples from horses and performs other related duties as required. This position may require non-traditional work hours, on an as needed basis, including evenings and/or weekends on short deadlines for certain assignments, with or without advance notice.

**EXPERIENCE:** Three (3) years of experience in the field of animal disease control or laboratory diagnostic work.

**LICENSE:** Appointees must possess a passing grade, as determined by the test sponsor, on the National Board Exam and the Clinical Competency test or equivalent test, or passage of the Educational Commission for Foreign Veterinary Graduates (ECFVG) of the American Veterinary Medical Association (AVMA), or the Program for the Assessment of Veterinary Education Equivalence (PAVE) of the American Association of Veterinary State Boards (AAVSB), or achievement of diplomat status in any (AVMA) specialty board.
