NUMBER OF POSITIONS: One (1)

<u>DUTIES</u>: Under direction of the Executive Director, New Jersey Racing Commission, assists in the administration of New Jersey Racing statutes; is responsible for the day-to-day operations of the Commission; performs other related duties as required.

REQUIREMENTS

EDUCATION: Graduation from an accredited college or university with a Bachelor's degree.

EXPERIENCE: Six (6) years of experience in the field of horse racing regulation, three (3) years of which shall have been in an administrative capacity.

<u>NOTE</u>: Applicants who do not possess the required degree may substitute additional experience as indicated above on a year-for-year basis with thirty (30) semester hour credits being equal to one (1) year of experience.

LICENSE: Appointee will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey.

NOTE: Appointee shall have been a resident of the State of New Jersey for at least five (5) years in accordance with N.J.S.A. 5:5-25.
