## **NUMBER OF POSITIONS AVAILABLE:** One (1)

<u>DUTIES</u>: Under the close supervision of a Weights and Measures Inspector 3 or other supervisory official in the State Office of Weights and Measures Metrology Laboratory, in a three-year training program, performs productive metrology laboratory work while receiving formal and on-the-job training in the inspection and testing of weighing and measuring devices; does other related duties as required.

## **REQUIREMENTS**

**LICENSE**: Appointees will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey.

<u>NOTE</u>: Appointees will be required to successfully complete the Weights and Measures training program conducted by the State Office of Weights & Measures, Department of Law and Public Safety, during the apprenticeship program.

**ADVANCEMENT:** Appointee's work performance will be reviewed and rated semi-annually during each twelve (12) months of the three (3) year apprenticeship program. Upon successful completion of the thirty-six (36) month apprenticeship program, appointees will be eligible for advancement to the title of Weights and Measures Inspector 1, in accordance with New Jersey Civil Service Commission procedures.

The inability of an employee in the apprentice title to satisfactorily complete the training period and/or attain a level of performance warranting advancement to the title of Weights and Measures Inspector 1, shall be considered cause for separation from employment.

**RESUME NOTE:** Eligibility determinations will be based upon information presented in resume only. Applicants who possess foreign degrees (degrees earned outside of the U.S.) are required to provide an evaluation indicating the U.S. equivalency prior to the closing date. Failure to do so may result in your ineligibility.

All offers of employment are conditional subject to the applicant agreeing to and then passing a background check that may include fingerprinting.
