NUMBER OF POSITIONS AVAILABLE: Twelve (12) as indicated above. Location preference required.

<u>DUTIES</u>: Under general supervision of a supervisory official in the Division of Law, performs legal research or writing, assists with case investigations, discovery review, trial preparation, subpoena preparation, federal case filings, and performs other related work as required.

REQUIREMENTS

EDUCATION: Graduation from an accredited college with a Bachelor's degree.

EXPERIENCE: Two (2) years of paralegal or legal/legislative research experience.

<u>NOTE</u>: Applicants who do not possess the required education may substitute additional experience as indicated above on a year for year basis.

NOTE: A Bachelor's degree in Law may be substituted for both the education and experience requirements listed above.

<u>NOTE</u>: Applicants who do not possess a Bachelor's degree may substitute an Associate's degree as a Legal Assistant or in Paralegal Studies or, successful completion of a two (2) year approved course in Paralegal Training at a recognized educational institution for two (2) years of college education.

LICENSE: Appointee will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle, rather than employee mobility, is necessary to perform the essential duties of the position.

PREFERENCE: Preference will be given to applicants with E-discovery and/or Relativity experience.
