<u>DUTIES</u>: Under general supervision in a state department or agency, leads a group of auditors conducting audits of financial transactions and records of private corporations, state, and local government, or local school districts, or independently conducts the more complex field or office audits or accounting work; does other related work.

REQUIREMENTS

NOTE: Applicants must meet one of the following or a combination of both experience and education. Thirty (30) semester hour credits are equal to one (1) year of relevant experience.

Six (6) years of professional accounting or auditing experience, including or supplemented by twenty-one (21) semester hour credits in accounting subjects.

OR

Possession of a Bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university, including or supplemented by twenty-one (21) semester hour credits in accounting subjects; and two (2) years of the above-mentioned professional experience.

OR

Possession of a valid certificate as a CPA issued by the NJ Board of Accountancy; and two (2) years of the above-mentioned professional experience.

<u>NOTE:</u> "Professional experience" refers to work that is creative, analytical, evaluative, and interpretive; requires a range and depth of specialized knowledge of the profession's principles, concepts, theories, and practices; and is performed with the authority to act according to one's own judgment and make accurate and informed decisions.

LICENSE: Appointees will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle, rather than employee mobility, is necessary to perform the essential duties of the position.

<u>NOTE</u>: Appointees may be required to possess a valid Commercial Driver's License (CDL) and applicable endorsements for the class and type of vehicles being operated.

RESUME NOTE: Eligibility determinations will be based upon information presented in the resume only. Applicants who possess foreign degrees (degrees earned outside of the U.S.) are required to provide an evaluation indicating the U.S. equivalency prior to the closing date.
