NUMBER OF VACANCIES: One (1)

DUTIES: Under the direction of the Information Security Unit Head, maintains the security posture for the Division's network resources. Monitors Division's network infrastructure for security related issues and potential threats, responds to cyber security alerts and conducts regular audits of both internal and external law enforcement entities to ensure compliance with State and Federal regulations. Manages the Division's centralized anti-virus and anti-malware solution. Serves on project teams provide expert information security analysis and recommendations. Must have fundamental knowledge of Linux operating systems, ability to utilize cyber security tools, and experience in writing computer scripts. May serve as a project manager for information security related projects. Does other duties as required,

REQUIREMENTS

EDUCATION: Graduation from an accredited college or university with a Bachelor's degree which must include a minimum of eighteen (18) semester hour credits in mathematics, and/or computer science.

<u>NOTE</u>: Applicants who do not possess the Bachelor's degree but possess the 18 semester hour credits may substitute additional experience as indicated below on a year-for-year basis with thirty (30) semester hour credits being equal to one (1) year of experience.

NOTE: Evidence of formal training in Computer Science/Information Technology received at an accredited institution may be submitted with your application for evaluation by the Civil Service Commission for possible credit. These training courses will be examined to see how they compare, both in hours/content, to college courses to which they equate, sixteen (16) training hours being equal to one (1) college credit. In-house training courses will not be accepted as meeting this criteria; thus, they will not be evaluated.

EXPERIENCE: Three (3) years of experience in the development, implementation, and maintenance of multi-network, multi-user Local Area Networks (LAN), Metropolitan Area Networks (MAN), and/or Wide Area Networks (WAN) environments.

<u>NOTE</u>: For positions involved in the administration of a Storage Area Network, in lieu of the above experience requirement, applicants must have three (3) years of experience installing, configuring, and supporting network hardware and software, at least one (1) year of which shall have been in the planning, implementation, and support of storage area network and related technologies.

LICENSE: Appointees will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle, rather than employee mobility, is necessary to perform the essential duties of the position.

RESUME NOTE: Eligibility determinations will be based upon information presented in the resume only. Applicants who possess foreign degrees (degrees earned outside of the U.S.) are required to provide an evaluation indicating the U.S. equivalency prior to the closing date. Failure to do so will result in your ineligibility.
