**DUTIES:** Under close supervision of a Fingerprint Processing Technician 2 or other supervisory officer in the Automated Fingerprint Identification Unit, State Identification Section, Records and Identification Bureau, Division of State Police; Department of Law and Public Safety, in a two (2) year training program, receives on-the-job training in the work involved in classifying, filing, researching, locating and identifying ten print, latent and partial fingerprints in the possession of the State Police; learns other related work duties as required.

**LICENSE:** Appointees will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle, rather than employee mobility, is necessary to perform the essential duties of the position.
