NUMBER OF POSITIONS AVAILABLE: Two (2) – Location preference is required.

<u>DUTIES</u>: Under direction of a Supervising Substance Abuse Counselor, Superintendent, or designee, provides cognitive behavioral treatment in both individual and group modalities to the young people in the facility, acts as a case consultant or supervises work of subordinate counselors and does varied tasks involved in assisting residents to make satisfactory social/emotional adjustments, reviews and submits reports for parole, probation services, and classification, does other related duties. REQUIREMENTS

<u>CERTIFICATION:</u> Applicants must possess a certificate as a Certified Alcohol and Drug Counselor (CADC), issued by the Board of Marriage and Family Therapy Examiners, New Jersey Division of Consumer Affairs, Department of Law and Public Safety.

NOTE: Applicants who possess the credentials as a Licensed Clinical Alcohol and Drug Counselor (LCADC) are considered to have met the above certification requirements.

EXPERIENCE: Two (2) years of experience in counseling or social work having responsibility for gathering and analyzing social or health information from clients, determination of their needs and planning and carrying out of a treatment plan geared to needs of individual clients, one (1) year of which shall have included experience with persons addicted to drugs or alcohol in a narcotic or alcohol treatment, prevention, and/or rehabilitation program.

LICENSE: Appointees will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle, rather than employee mobility, is necessary to perform essential duties of the position.

RESUME NOTE: Eligibility determination will be based upon information presented in resume only. Applicants who possess foreign degrees (degrees earned outside of the U.S.) are required to provide an evaluation indicating the U.S. equivalency prior to the closing date. Failure to do so may result in your ineligibility.

All offers of employment are conditional subject to the applicant agreeing to and then passing a background check that may include fingerprinting.
