REQUIREMENTS

EXPERIENCE: Three (3) years of experience in the direct care and/or training of children with social, emotional, psychological, and/or behavioral problems in a residential or community centered program.

OR

EDUCATION: Completion of thirty (30) semester hour credits from an accredited college, which shall have included at least twelve (12) semester hour credits in the behavioral sciences.

AND

EXPERIENCE: Two (2) years of experience in the direct care and/or training of children with social, emotional, psychological, and/or behavioral problems in a residential or community centered program.

NOTE: Applicants who do not possess the thirty (30) semester credit hours but who do possess the twelve (12) specific credits as indicated above may substitute additional experience for the remaining education on a year-for-year basis (thirty (30) semester hour credits equals one (1) year of experience).

LICENSE: Appointee will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle, rather than employee mobility, is necessary to perform the essential duties of the position.
