

## NEW JERSEY NALOXONE REBATE PROGRAM

**UPDATED JUNE 1, 2017**

### Eligibility Requirements

- Non-federal governmental entities located within New Jersey, including but not limited to state agencies, county or other local governments and their agencies, law enforcement agencies and non-profit volunteer EMS agencies.
- In the event that entities distribute or resell syringes to other entities, only the last purchaser is eligible to receive the rebate.
- Only purchases of naloxone syringes manufactured by Amphastar are eligible for the rebate; the additional components of a naloxone kit (e.g., nasal atomization adaptors) are not eligible for the rebate.
- Entities that purchase naloxone syringes directly from Amphastar or from a third party (including wholesale distributors) are eligible for the rebate.
- Only Amphastar manufactured naloxone syringe purchases made between June 1, 2017 and May 31, 2018 are eligible for the rebate payment.

### Rebate Submission Requirements

- Please submit the rebate request form along with supporting documentation (e.g., a copy of your sales receipt or order confirmation sheet) for the naloxone syringes purchased.
- **Supporting documentation must include the following information:**
  - Name of agency making the purchase;
  - Purchase date;
  - Number of naloxone syringes purchased;
  - Item or National Drug Code (NDC) number to verify the syringes are Amphastar syringes;
  - Price paid; and
  - Proof of payment.
- Ensure the date of purchase on the proof of payment falls within the dates listed on the rebate request form, or your request will not be processed.
- A separate rebate request must be submitted at the end of each calendar quarter for both years of the agreement (due dates are August 31<sup>st</sup>, November 30<sup>th</sup>, February 28<sup>th</sup> and May 31<sup>st</sup>).
