INDICTMENT

JOHN RAUSHI)

The Grand Jurors of and for the State of New Jersey, upon their oaths, present that:

COUNT ONE

(Tampering with Public Records or Information - Third Degree)

JOHN RAUSHI

between in or about July 2004 and in or about September 2004, at the Township of Hanover, in the County of Morris, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, with purpose to defraud or injure another, did make a false alteration of a record, document or thing belonging to, or received or kept by, the government for information or record, or required by law to be kept by others for information of the government, that is, the said JOHN RAUSHI, with purpose to defraud another, did alter the date on an expired Public Works Contractor Registration Certificate, which is required under the Public Works Contractor Registration Act, N.J.S.A. 34:11-56.48 to 57, before a public contractor is allowed to perform public work, to falsely reflect a valid expiration date, the Public works Contractor

Registration Certificate being a document or thing belonging to, or received or kept by, the government for information or record, or required by law to be kept by others for information of the government, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:28-7a(1), and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.

COUNT TWO


(Tampering with Public Records or Information - Third Degree)

JOHN RAUSHI

between in or about July 2004 and in or about September 2004, at the Township of Hanover, and at the Township of Rockaway, in the County of Morris, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, with purpose to defraud or injure another, did make, present, offer for filing or use any record, document or thing knowing it to be false, and with purpose that it be taken as a genuine part of information or records belonging to, or received or kept by, the government for information or record, or required by law to be kept by others for information of the government, that is, the said JOHN RAUSHI, with purpose to defraud or injure another, did make, present or offer for filing or use an expired Public Works Contractor Registration Certificate, which is required under the Public Works Contractor Registration Act, N.J.S.A. 34:11-56.48 to 57, before a public contractor is allowed to perform public work, which the said JOHN RAUSHI knew had been altered to falsely reflect a valid expiration date, and with purpose that it be taken as a genuine part of information or records belonging to, or received or kept by, the government for information or record, or required by law to be kept


by others for information of the government, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:28-7a(2), and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.


