The Grand Jurors of and for the State of New Jersey,
upon their oaths, present that:

COUNT ONE

(Possession With Intent to Distribute a Controlled
Dangerous Substance - First Degree)

JAMES ELLIS

on or about October 15, 2007, at the Township of Mount Holly, in
the County of Burlington, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction
of this Court, knowingly or purposely did possess with intent to
distribute a controlled dangerous substance, that is, cocaine, in
a quantity of five ounces or more including any adulterants or
dilutants, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:35-5a(1) and
N.J.S.A. 2C:35-5b(1), and against the peace of this State, the
government and dignity of the same.

COUNT TWO

(Distribution of a Controlled Dangerous
Substance - Second Degree)

JAMES ELLIS

on or about October 5, 2006, at the Township of Bordentown, in the County of Burlington, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, knowingly or purposely did distribute a controlled dangerous substance, that is, cocaine, in a quantity of one-half ounce or more, including any adulterants or dilutants, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:35-5a(1) and N.J.S.A. 2C:35-5b(2), and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.

COUNT THREE

(Distribution of a Controlled Dangerous
Substance - Second Degree)

JAMES ELLIS

on or about October 12, 2006, at the Township of Bordentown, in the County of Burlington, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, knowingly or purposely did distribute a controlled dangerous substance, that is, cocaine, in a quantity of one-half ounce or more, including any adulterants or dilutants, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:35-5a(1) and N.J.S.A. 2C:35-5b(2), and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.

COUNT FOUR

(Possession of a Weapon During Commission of
Certain Crimes - Second Degree)

JAMES ELLIS


on or about October 15, 2007, at the Township of Mount Holly, in the County of Burlington, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, knowingly did possess a firearm, that is, a Ruger P90DC, semi-automatic handgun, while in the course of committing, attempting to commit or conspiring to commit a violation of the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:35-5, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:39-4.1a, and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.

COUNT FIVE

(Certain Persons Not To Have Weapons - Second Degree)


JAMES ELLIS

on or about October 15, 2007, at the Township of Mount Holly, in the County of Burlington, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, having been convicted on November 20, 1981, of the crime of Burglary, on Indictment I674-80, having been convicted on February 24, 1984, of the crime of Robbery, on Indictment I252-83, and having been convicted on November 7, 1997, of the crimes of Distribution of a Controlled Dangerous Substance, on Indictments BUR 96-12-00967-I, BUR 97-03-00144-I, and BUR 97-07-00467-I; did purchase, own, possess or control a firearm, that is, a Ruger P90DC, semi-automatic handgun, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:39-7b(1), and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.
