JASHER GUERRERO

The Grand Jurors of and for the State of New Jersey, upon their oaths, present that:

COUNT ONE

(Bribery in Official Matters - Second Degree)

JASHER GUERRERO

between in or about September 2003 and in or about June 2005, at the Borough of Union Beach, in the County of Monmouth, at the City of Elizabeth, in the County of Union, and at the City of Trenton, in the County of Mercer, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, knowingly conferred or caused to be conferred upon, an employee of a State agency whose identity is known to the Grand Jurors, a benefit, that is, monetary payments in excess of \$40,000, as consideration for the performance of official duties of the said employee of a State agency, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:27-2d, and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of same.

COUNT TWO

(Official Misconduct - Second Degree)

JASHER GUERRERO

between in or about September 2003 and continuing until in or about June 2005, at the Borough of Union Beach, in the County of Monmouth, at the City of Elizabeth, in the County of Union, and at the City of Trenton, in the County of Mercer, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, did commit the offense of official misconduct by aiding or agreeing or attempting to aid an employee of a State agency whose identity is known to the Grand Jurors in planning or committing official misconduct; that is, an employee of a State agency whose identity is known to the Grand Jurors, acting with a purpose to obtain a benefit for himself in an amount in excess of \$200, knowingly did commit acts relating to his office but constituting an unauthorized exercise of his official functions, knowing that such acts were unauthorized or that he committed the said acts in an unauthorized manner, that is, the said employee of a State agency whose identity is known to the Grand Jurors, having thereby the official functions and duties, among others, to refrain from receiving any benefit, arising from and in connection with, any person doing business with his agency; to display good faith, honesty and integrity; to be impervious to corrupting influences; and to conduct himself with undivided loyalty to his public trust, the said duties being imposed by law or clearly inherent in the

nature of his office, the said employee of a State agency whose identity is known to the Grand Jurors did accept monetary payments in excess of \$40,000 from JASHER GUERRERO, owner of Pro Painting & General Contracting and of Pro General Contracting, Inc., in exchange for the State employee whose identity is known to the Grand Jurors helping JASHER GUERRERO obtain contracts for Pro Painting & General Contracting and Pro General Contracting, Inc., from the agency in which the State employee whose identity is known to the Grand Jurors was employed, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:30-2a and N.J.S.A. 2C:2-6, and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of same.

COUNT THREE

(Misconduct by a Corporate Official - Second Degree)

JASHER GUERRERO

between in or about July 2004 and in or about June 2005, at the Borough of Union Beach, in the County of Monmouth, at the City of Elizabeth, in the County of Union, and at the City of Trenton, in the County of Mercer, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, did knowingly use a corporation, that is, Pro General Contracting, Inc., a corporation of the State of New Jersey, for the furtherance of criminal objects, that is the crimes of Bribery, in violation of N.J.S.A. 2C:27-2d, and Official Misconduct, in violation of N.J.S.A. 2C:30-2a and N.J.S.A. 2C:2-6, thereby deriving a benefit in excess of \$75,000, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:21-9c, and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of same.
