The Grand Jurors of and for the State of New Jersey, upon their oaths, present that:

COUNT ONE

(Conspiracy - Second Degree)

ELVIN SIERRA-SANTIAGO

MIGUEL COREA-DIAZ

MANUEL SAVEDRA

GILBERTO BADILLO

FREDIS VENTURA

ALEJANDRO HUEZCA

and

ANIBAL ORTIZ

who are named as the defendants herein, and another individual, whose identity is known to the Grand Jurors, who is named as a conspirator but not as a defendant herein, between on or about December 1, 2008, and on or about August 27, 2009, at the City of Long Branch and at the Borough of Eatontown, both in the County Monmouth, at the Township of Hamilton, in the County of Mercer, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, with the purpose of promoting or facilitating the commission of the crimes of distribution of a controlled dangerous substance and possession with intent to distribute a controlled dangerous substance, did agree that:

- A. One or more of them knowingly would engage in conduct which would constitute the aforesaid crimes, or
- B. One or more of them knowingly would aid in the planning, solicitation or commission of said crimes, that is:
- 1. Knowingly or purposely to distribute a controlled dangerous substance, that is, cocaine, in a quantity of five ounces or more including any adulterants or dilutants, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:35-5a(1) and N.J.S.A. 2C:35-5b(1).
- 2. Knowingly or purposely to possess with intent to distribute a controlled dangerous substance, that is, cocaine, in a quantity of five ounces or more including any adulterants or dilutants, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:35-5a(1) and N.J.S.A. 2C:35-5b(1).

All in violation of N.J.S.A. 2C:5-2, and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.

COUNT TWO

(Distribution of a Controlled Dangerous Substance - First Degree)

between on or about March 5, 2009, and on or about May 20, 2009, at the City of Long Branch, in the County of Monmouth, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, knowingly or purposely did distribute a controlled dangerous substance, that is, cocaine, in an aggregate quantity of five ounces or more including any adulterants or dilutants, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:35-5a(1), N.J.S.A. 2C:35-5b(1), N.J.S.A. 2C:35-5c and N.J.S.A. 2C:2-6, and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.

COUNT THREE

(Distribution of a Controlled Dangerous Substance - Second Degree)

on or about April 3, 2009, at the City of Long Branch, in the County of Monmouth, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, knowingly or purposely did distribute a controlled dangerous substance, cocaine, in a quantity of one-half ounce or more including any adulterants or dilutants, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:35-5a(1), N.J.S.A. 2C:35-5b(2), and N.J.S.A. 2C:2-6, and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.

COUNT FOUR

(Possession with Intent to Distribute a Controlled Dangerous Substance - Second Degree)

ALEJANDRO HUEZCA

on or about April 3, 2009, at the City of Long Branch, in the County of Monmouth, at the Township of Hamilton, in the County of Mercer, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, knowingly or purposely did possess with intent to distribute a controlled dangerous substance, that is, cocaine, in a quantity of one-half ounce or more including any adulterants or dilutants, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:35-5a(1) and N.J.S.A. 2C:35-5b(2), and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.

COUNT FIVE

(Distribution of a Controlled Dangerous Substance - Second Degree)

MANUEL SAVEDRA

FREDIS VENTURA

and

ANIBAL ORTIZ

between on or about July 1, 2009, and on or about August 17, 2009, at the City of Long Branch, in the County of Monmouth, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, knowingly or purposely did distribute a controlled dangerous substance, that is, cocaine, in an aggregate quantity of one-half ounce or more including any adulterants or dilutants, that is, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:35-5a(1), N.J.S.A. 2C:35-5b(2), N.J.S.A. 2C:35-5c, and N.J.S.A. 2C:2-6, and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.

COUNT SIX

(Distribution of a Controlled Dangerous Substance - Second Degree)

between on or about June 30, 2009, and on or about August 13, 2009, at the City of Long Branch, in the County of Monmouth, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, knowingly or purposely did distribute a controlled dangerous substance, that is, cocaine, in an aggregate quantity of one-half ounce or more including any adulterants or dilutants, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:35-5a(1), N.J.S.A. 2C:35-5b(2), N.J.S.A. 2C:35-5c, and N.J.S.A. 2C:2-6, and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.

COUNT SEVEN

(Possession with Intent to Distribute a Controlled Dangerous Substance - Third Degree)

FREDIS VENTURA

on or about August 27, 2009, at the City of Long Branch, in the County of Monmouth, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, knowingly or purposely did possess with intent to distribute a controlled dangerous substance, that is, cocaine, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:35-5a(1) and N.J.S.A. 2C:35-5b(3), and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.

COUNT EIGHT

(Possession with Intent to Distribute a Controlled Dangerous Substance - Second Degree)

MIGUEL COREA-DIAZ

and

MANUEL SAVEDRA

on or about August 27, 2009, at the Borough of Eatontown, in the County of Monmouth, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, knowingly or purposely did possess with intent to distribute a controlled dangerous substance, that is, cocaine, in a quantity of one-half ounce or more including any adulterants or dilutants, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:35-5a(1), N.J.S.A. 2C:35-5b(2), and N.J.S.A. 2C:2-6, and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.

COUNT NINE

(Possession with Intent to Distribute a Controlled Dangerous Substance - Second Degree)

MIGUEL COREA-DIAZ

on or about August 27, 2009, at the City of Long Branch, in the County of Monmouth, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, knowingly or purposely did possess with intent to distribute a controlled dangerous substance, that is, cocaine, in a quantity of one-half ounce or more including any adulterants or dilutants, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:35-5a(1) and N.J.S.A. 2C:35-5b(2), and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.

COUNT TEN

(Possession with Intent to Distribute a Controlled Dangerous Substance - Third Degree)

MANUEL SAVEDRA

on or about August 27, 2009, at the City of Long Branch, in the County of Monmouth, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, knowingly or purposely did possess with intent to distribute a controlled dangerous substance, that is, cocaine, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:35-5a(1) and N.J.S.A. 2C:35-5b(3), and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.

COUNT ELEVEN

(Employing a Juvenile in a Drug Distribution Scheme - Second Degree)

MIGUEL COREA-DIAZ

and

MANUEL SAVEDRA

between on or about April 2, 2009, and on or about August 27, 2009, at the City of Long Branch, in the County of Monmouth, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, being at least 18 years of age, knowingly did use, solicit, direct, hire of employ a person 17 years of age or younger, that is, J.U., to violate N.J.S.A. 2C:35-5a, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:35-6, and N.J.S.A. 2C:2-6, and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.
