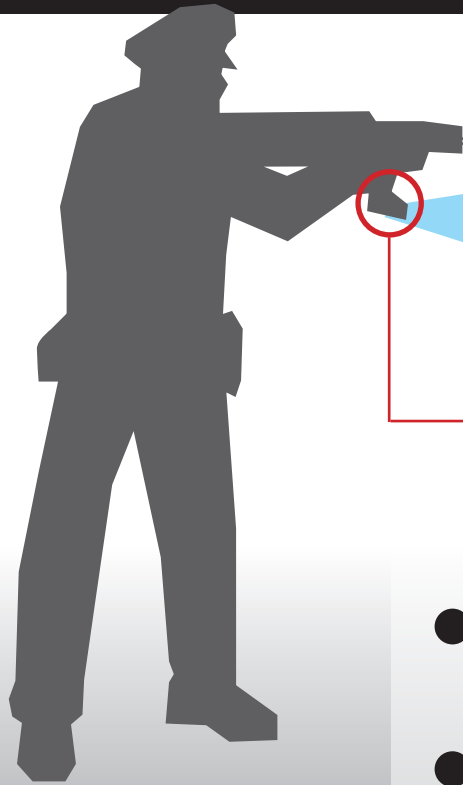
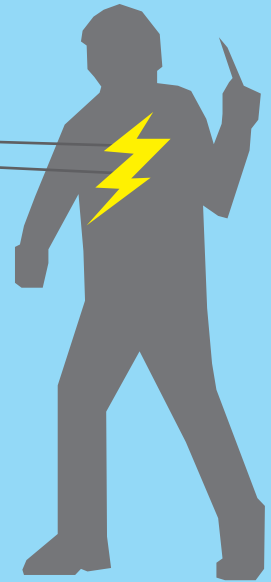




Attorney General's New Stun Gun Policy

- New Jersey is last state in U.S. to authorize use of stun guns by law enforcement officers.
- Lifts restrictions on stun guns to give police practical alternative to deadly force in appropriate situations.
- Stun guns may NOT be used to subdue a person who is passively resisting law enforcement commands.
- Strict safeguards include requirement that stun guns record every incident with a built-in video camera.
- Stun guns can save the lives of police officers, innocent victims and violent suspects.
