INDICTMENT

STEPHANIE BENNETT)

The Grand Jurors of and for the State of New Jersey, upon
their oaths, present that:

COUNT ONE

(Aggravated Sexual Assault - First Degree)

STEPHANIE BENNETT

between on or about November 30, 2010, and on or about February
16, 2011, in the Boro of Woodbine, in the County of Cape May,
elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, did commit
an act of sexual penetration with another person, namely M.B.,
when said M.B. was less than 13 years old, contrary to the
provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:14-2(a)(1), and against the peace of
this State, the government and dignity of the same.

COUNT TWO

(Endangering the Welfare of a Child - Second Degree)

STEPHANIE BENNETT

between on or about November 30, 2010, and on or about February 16, 2011, in the Boro of Woodbine, in the County of Cape May, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, did cause or permit a child, namely M.B., to engage in a prohibited sexual act or in the simulation of such an act, as defined by N.J.S.A. 2C:24-4(b)(1), when said STEPHANIE BENNETT, knew, had reason to know, or intended that the prohibited act may be photographed or filmed, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:24-4(b)(3) and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.

COUNT THREE

(Endangering the Welfare of a Child - Second Degree)

STEPHANIE BENNETT

between on or about November 30, 2010, and on or about February 16, 2011, in the Boro of Woodbine, in the County of Cape May, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, did photograph or film a child, namely M.B., in a prohibited sexual act, or in the simulation of such an act, as defined in N.J.S.A. 2C:24-4(b)(1), contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:24-4(b)(4) and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.

COUNT FOUR

(Endangering the Welfare of a Child - Second Degree)

STEPHANIE BENNETT

between on or about November 30, 2010, and on or about February 16, 2011, in the Boro of Woodbine, in the County of Cape May, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, did engage in sexual conduct which would impair or debauch the morals of a child, namely M.B., contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:24-4(a), and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.

COUNT FIVE

(Endangering the Welfare of a Child - Second Degree)

STEPHANIE BENNETT


between on or about November 30, 2010, and on or about February 16, 2011, in the Boro of Woodbine, in the County of Cape May, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, did knowingly give, provide, mail, deliver, transfer, distribute, circulate, or disseminate, through any means, including the Internet, a photograph, film, videotape, or computer program or file, which depicted a child, namely M.B., engaging in a prohibited sexual act, or simulation of such an act, as defined by N.J.S.A. 2C:24-4(b) (1), contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:24-4(b) (5) (a), and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.

COUNT SIX


(Endangering the Welfare of a Child - Fourth Degree)

STEPHANIE BENNETT

between on or about November 30, 2010, and on or about February 16, 2011, in the Boro of Woodbine, in the County of Cape May, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, did knowingly possess or knowingly view any photograph, film, videotape, computer program or file, video game or any other reproduction or reconstruction which depicted a child engaging in a prohibited sexual act, as defined by N.J.S.A. 2C:24-4(b)(1), contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:24-4(b)(5)(b), and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.
