## UPDATE: Project Medicine Drop

*Unused and Expired Medications Deposited at Project Medicine Drop boxes since November 14, 2011:*

- ▶ Little Falls Police Dept.: Approximately 80 pounds
- ▶ Seaside Heights Police Dept.: Approximately 40 pounds
- ▶ Vineland Police Dept.: Approximately 300 pounds

Project Medicine Drop is a pilot program in which the Division of Consumer Affairs installed “prescription drug drop boxes” at three New Jersey police departments – those in Little Falls, Seaside Heights, and Vineland.

The boxes give members of the public the opportunity to dispose of their unused and expired medications safely, securely, and anonymously, seven days a week, 365 days a year.
