(Theft by Deception - Second Degree)

PATRICK ANDERSON

and

AAA INVESTMENTS,

on or about February 9, 2007, at the City of Orange, in the County of Essex, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, purposely did obtain the property of another by deception, in an amount of \$75,000 or more, to wit approximately \$999,000 dollars, by creating or reinforcing false impressions to Bear Stearns Residential Mortgage Corporation that mortgage loan applications and U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) settlement forms contained true and accurate information, WHEREAS IN TRUTH AND IN FACT, as the said PATRICK ANDERSON, and AAA INVESTMENTS., well knew, the submitted mortgage loan applications and U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) settlement forms did not contain true and accurate information and thereby caused the said Bear Stearns Residential Mortgage Corporation to provide mortgages in an amount of \$75,000 or more, to wit approximately \$999,000 dollars, contrary to the provisions of <u>N.J.S.A</u> 2C:20-4, <u>N.J.S.A</u>. 2C:2-6 and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.

(Theft by Deception - Second Degree)

on or about August 6, 2008, at the City of Orange, in the County of Essex, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, purposely did obtain the property of another by deception, in an amount of \$75,000 or more, to wit approximately \$337,487 dollars, by creating or reinforcing false impressions to American Financial Resources, Inc., that mortgage loan applications and U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) settlement forms contained true and accurate information, WHEREAS IN TRUTH AND IN FACT, as the said PATRICK ANDERSON, RONALD L. BLANCHETTE, JR., and AAA INVESTMENTS., well knew, the submitted mortgage loan applications and U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) settlement forms did not contain true and accurate information and thereby caused the said American Financial Resources, Inc., to provide mortgages in an amount of \$75,000 or more, to wit approximately \$337,487 dollars, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A 2C:20-4, N.J.S.A. 2C:2-6 and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.

COUNT THREE

(Financial Facilitation of Criminal Activity - Third Degree)

PATRICK ANDERSON

and

AAA INVESTMENTS,

between on or about August 6, 2008 and August 11, 2008, at the City of Orange, in the County of Essex, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, did engage in transactions involving property, in an amount less than \$75,000, known or which a reasonable person would believe to be derived from criminal activity, knowing that the transaction was designed in whole or in part to conceal or disguise the nature, location, source, ownership or control of the property derived from criminal activity, that is the said PATRICK ANDERSON and AAA INVESTMENTS did engage in the transactions of issuing, receiving, wiring and causing to be submitted checks, in an amount less than \$75,000, known to be derived from criminal activity, knowing that the transactions were designed in whole or in part to conceal or disguise the nature, location, source, ownership or control of the property which the said PATRICK ANDERSON, and AAA INVESTMENTS., knew to be derived from criminal activity, contrary to the provisions of <u>N.J.S.A.</u> '2C:21-25(b)(2)(a), <u>N.J.S.A</u> 2C:2-6 and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.

BLANCHETTE, JR., and AAA INVESTMENTS., well knew, the submitted mortgage loan applications and U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) settlement forms did not contain true and accurate information and thereby caused the said Sovereign Bank, to provide mortgages in an amount of \$75,000 or more, to wit approximately \$445,500 dollars, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A 2C:20-4, N.J.S.A. 2C:2-6 and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.

(Theft by Deception - Second Degree)

on or about October 27, 2008, at the City of Orange, in the County of Essex, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, purposely did obtain the property of another by deception, in an amount of \$75,000 or more, to wit approximately \$408,000 dollars, by creating or reinforcing false impressions to Golden First Mortgage Corporation that mortgage loan applications and U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) settlement forms contained true and accurate information, WHEREAS IN TRUTH AND IN FACT, as the said PATRICK ANDERSON, and AAA INVESTMENTS., well knew, the submitted mortgage loan applications and U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) settlement forms did not contain true and accurate information and thereby caused the said Golden First Mortgage Corporation, to provide mortgages in an amount of \$75,000 or more, to wit approximately
