The Grand Jurors of and for the State of New Jersey, upon
their oaths, present that:

COUNT ONE

(Conspiracy - Second Degree)

TERREL GOODWIN

JOSHUA RIVERA

WESLEY BOWLEG

ERIC WHITE

KYLE MILLS

STEPHEN FORTUNE

JOSEPH FLORES

and

GEORGE SMITH

between on or about June 15, 2017, and on or about November 30, 2017, at the Cities of Bridgeton and Vineland, in the County of Cumberland, at the Township of Deptford, in the County of Gloucester, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, with the purpose of promoting or facilitating the commission of the crime of Distribution of Controlled Dangerous Substances, did agree together that:

1. One or more of them would engage in conduct which would constitute the aforesaid crime, or
2. One or more of them would aid in the planning, solicitation or commission of said crimes, that is:
 - A. Knowingly or purposely distribute a controlled dangerous substance, that is, cocaine, in a quantity of five

ounces or more, including any adulterants or dilutants, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:35-5a(1), N.J.S.A. 2C:35-5b(1), and N.J.S.A. 2C:35-5c.

All in violation of N.J.S.A. 2C:5-2, and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.

COUNT TWO

(Promoting Organized Street Crime - First Degree)

TERREL GOODWIN

between on or about June 15, 2017, and on or about November 30, 2017, at the Cities of Bridgeton and Vineland, in the County of Cumberland, at the Township of Deptford, in the County of Gloucester, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, knowingly did conspire with others as an organizer, supervisor, financier or manager, to commit one or more of the crimes enumerated in N.J.S.A. 2C:33-30, specifically, Possession with Intent to Distribute Controlled Dangerous Substances, in violation of N.J.S.A. 2C:35-5a(1) and N.J.S.A. 2C:35-5b(3), and Distribution of Controlled Dangerous Substances, in violation of N.J.S.A. 2C:35-5a(1) and N.J.S.A. 2C:35-5b(1), contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:33-30, and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.

COUNT THREE

(Possession of a Controlled Dangerous Substance - Third Degree)

TERREL GOODWIN

between on or about September 22, 2017, and on or about November 30, 2017, at the Cities of Bridgeton and Vineland, in the County of Cumberland, at the Township of Deptford, in the County of Gloucester, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, knowingly or purposely did possess a controlled dangerous substance, that is, cocaine, a Schedule II controlled dangerous substance, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:35-10a(1), and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.

COUNT FOUR

(Possession of a Controlled Dangerous Substance - Third Degree)

GEORGE SMITH

on or about November 16, 2017, at the Township of Deptford, in the County of Gloucester, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, knowingly or purposely did possess a controlled dangerous substance, that is, cocaine, a Schedule II controlled dangerous substance, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:35-10a(1), N.J.S.A. 2C:2-6, and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.

COUNT FIVE

(Possession of a Controlled Dangerous Substance - Third Degree)

ALEXANDER TORRES

on or about November 30, 2017, at the City of Vineland, in the County of Cumberland, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, knowingly or purposely did possess a controlled dangerous substance, that is, heroin, a Schedule I controlled dangerous substance, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:35-10a(1), and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.

COUNT SIX

(Possession of a Controlled Dangerous Substance - Third Degree)

ALEXANDER TORRES

on or about November 30, 2017, at the City of Vineland, in the County of Cumberland, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, knowingly or purposely did possess a controlled dangerous substance, that is, dibutylone, a Schedule I controlled dangerous substance, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:35-10a(1), and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.

COUNT SEVEN

(Distribution of a Controlled Dangerous Substance - First Degree)

TERREL GOODWIN

between on or about September 22, 2017, and on or about November 16, 2017, at the Township of Deptford, in the County of Gloucester, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, knowingly or purposely did distribute a controlled dangerous substance, that is, cocaine, in a quantity of five ounces or more, including any adulterants or dilutants, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:35-5a(1), N.J.S.A. 2C:35-5b(1), N.J.S.A. 2C:35-5c, N.J.S.A. 2C:2-6, and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.

COUNT EIGHT

(Possession with Intent to Distribute a Controlled Dangerous Substance - Third Degree)

TERREL GOODWIN

on or about November 30, 2017, at the City of Vineland, in the County of Cumberland, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, knowingly or purposely did possess with intent to distribute a controlled dangerous substance, that is, cocaine, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:35-5a(1), N.J.S.A. 2C:35-5b(3), and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.

COUNT NINE

(Distribution of a Controlled Dangerous Substance - First Degree)

GEORGE SMITH

on or about November 16, 2017, at the Township of Deptford, in the County of Gloucester, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, knowingly or purposely did distribute a controlled dangerous substance, that is, cocaine, in a quantity of five ounces or more, including any adulterants or dilutants, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:35-5a(1), N.J.S.A. 2C:35-5b(1), N.J.S.A. 2C:2-6, and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.

COUNT TEN

(Maintaining or Operating a Controlled Dangerous Substance
Production Facility - First Degree)

ALEXANDER TORRES

on or about November 30, 2017, at the City of Vineland, in the
County of Cumberland, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of
this Court, knowingly did maintain or operate, or participate in
the maintenance or operations of a premises, place or facility
used for manufacturing a controlled dangerous substance, that
is, heroin and/or dibutylone, contrary to the provisions of
N.J.S.A. 2C:35-4, and against the peace of this State, the
government and dignity of the same.

COUNT ELEVEN

(Possession with Intent to Distribute a Controlled Dangerous Substance - Second Degree)

ALEXANDER TORRES

on or about November 30, 2017, at the City of Vineland, in the County of Cumberland, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, knowingly or purposely did possess with intent to distribute a controlled dangerous substance, that is, heroin, a Schedule I controlled dangerous substance, in a quantity of one-half ounce or more, including any adulterants or dilutants, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:35-5a(1), N.J.S.A. 2C:35-5b(2), and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.

COUNT TWELVE

(Possession with Intent to Distribute a Controlled Dangerous Substance - Third Degree)

ALEXANDER TORRES

on or about November 30, 2017, at the City of Vineland, in the County of Cumberland, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, knowingly or purposely did possess with intent to distribute a controlled dangerous substance, that is, dibutylone, a Schedule I controlled dangerous substance, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:35-5a(1), N.J.S.A. 2C:35-5b(13), and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.

COUNT THIRTEEN

(Unlawful Possession of an Assault Firearm - Second Degree)

ALEXANDER TORRES

on or about November 30, 2017, at the City of Vineland, in the County of Cumberland, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, knowingly did have in his possession an assault firearm, that is, a 308 Winchester caliber Valmet semiautomatic rifle, serial number 395477, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:39-5f, and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.

COUNT FOURTEEN

(Unlawful Possession of an Assault Rifle - Second Degree)

ALEXANDER TORRES

on or about November 30, 2017, at the City of Vineland, in the County of Cumberland, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, knowingly did have in his possession an assault firearm, that is, a 9mm Luger caliber FMJ (Cobray) semiautomatic pistol, serial number 94-0007511, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:39-5f, and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.

COUNT FIFTEEN

(Unlawful Possession of a Large Capacity Magazine - Fourth Degree)

ALEXANDER TORRES

on or about November 30, 2017, at the City of Vineland, in the County of Cumberland, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, knowingly did possess a large capacity ammunition magazine, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:39-3j, and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.

COUNT SIXTEEN

(Possession of a Firearm During the Commission of Certain Crimes
- Second Degree)

ALEXANDER TORRES

on or about November 30, 2017, at the City of Vineland, in the County of Cumberland, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, knowingly did possess certain weapons, that is, a .22 Long Rifle caliber Jimenez Arms semiautomatic pistol, serial number restored to 1146838; and/or a 7.62x39mm caliber Romarm semiautomatic rifle, serial number S1-22792-2000; and/or a 7.62x39mm caliber Norinco semiautomatic rifle, serial number 25002790; and/or a 9mm Luger caliber MasterPiece Arms semiautomatic pistol, serial number F17703; and/or a 308 Winchester caliber Valmet semiautomatic rifle, serial number 395477; and/or a 9mm Luger caliber FMJ (Cobray) semiautomatic pistol, serial number 94-0007511, while in the course of committing or attempting to commit a violation of N.J.S.A. 2C:35-5, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:39-4.1a, and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.

COUNT SEVENTEEN

(Certain Persons Not to Possess Weapons - Second Degree)

ALEXANDER TORRES

on or about November 30, 2017, at the City of Vineland, in the County of Cumberland, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, having been convicted of the crime of Fourth Degree Manufacture, Transport, Disposition and Defacement of Weapons in Cumberland County under Indictment 08-01-86-I, did own, possess or control the following firearms: a 22 Long Rifle caliber Jimenez Arms semiautomatic pistol, serial number restored to 1146838; and/or a 7.62x39mm caliber Romarm semiautomatic rifle, serial number S1-22792-2000; and/or 7.62x39mm caliber Norinco semiautomatic rifle, serial number 25002790; and/or 9mm Luger caliber MasterPiece Arms semiautomatic pistol, serial number F17703; and/or a 308 Winchester caliber Valmet semiautomatic rifle, serial number 395477; and/or a 9mm Luger caliber FMJ (Cobray) semiautomatic pistol, serial number 94-0007511,

contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:39-7b, and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.
