The Grand Jurors of and for the State of New Jersey, upon their oaths, present that:

COUNT ONE

Endangering the Welfare of a Child  
(Distribution of 25 or More Items of Child Pornography -  
Second Degree)

GREGORY VAN SCIVER

between on or about September 9, 2017, and on or about October 18, 2017, at the Township of Lumberton, in the County of Burlington, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, did knowingly distribute twenty-five or more items depicting the sexual exploitation or abuse of a child, as defined by N.J.S.A. 2C:24-4b(1), contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:24-4b(5)(a)(i), and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.

COUNT TWO

Endangering the Welfare of a Child  
(Storing or Maintaining 25 or More Items of Child Pornography  
Using a File-Sharing Program -  
Second Degree)

GREGORY VAN SCIVER

between on or about September 9, 2017, and on or about April 3, 2018, at the Township of Lumberton, in the County of Burlington, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, did knowingly store or maintain 25 or more items depicting the sexual exploitation or abuse of a child, as defined by N.J.S.A. 2C:24-4b(1), using a file-sharing program which was designated as available for searching by or copying to one or more other computers, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:24-4b(5)(a)(iii), and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.

COUNT THREE

Endangering the Welfare of a Child

(Possession of 1,000 or More Items of Child Pornography -  
Second Degree)

GREGORY VAN SCIVER

on or about April 3, 2018, at the Township of Lumberton, in the County of Burlington, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, did knowingly possess, view, or have under his control, through any means, including the Internet, 1,000 or more items depicting the sexual exploitation or abuse of a child, as defined by N.J.S.A. 2C:24-4b(1), contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:24-4b(5)(b)(ii), and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.

COUNT FOUR

Endangering the Welfare of a Child  
(Manufacturing Child Pornography -  
Second Degree)

GREGORY VAN SCIVER

between on or about July 24, 2012, and on or about April 3,  
2018, at the Township of Lumberton, in the County of Burlington,  
elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, did  
knowingly photograph or film a child in a prohibited sexual act  
or in the simulation of such an act or use any device, including  
a computer, to reproduce or reconstruct the image of a child in  
a prohibited sexual act or in the simulation of such an act, as  
defined by N.J.S.A. 2C:24-4b(1), contrary to the provisions of  
N.J.S.A. 2C:24-4b(4), and against the peace of this State, the  
government and dignity of the same.
