NOTICE OF CHARGES

Take Notice that under the authority of the Director, as set forth in Alcoholic Beverage Control Act, N.J.S.A 33:1-1, et seq; and the regulations promulgated pursuant thereto, the New Jersey Division of Alcoholic Beverage Control (“Division”) will seek to suspend plenary retail license 2012-33-030-002 held by C557 LLC, issued by Borough Council of Plainfield City, Union County, for premises located at 315 E Fifth St, Plainfield, NJ 07060, for violation of the aforementioned statute and/or regulations. The Division hereby prefers the following charges and will seek the noted penalty to wit:

1. On or about 4/18/20, you engaged in, allowed, permitted or suffered 10-day suspension the violation of Executive Orders 103, 104 and/or 107 issued by Governor Philip D. Murphy by allowing patrons to eat and/or drink at your licensed premise.

The total penalty sought by the Division is 10 days suspension of your license.

The licensee must enter a plea to the charges within 30 days of its receipt. Failure to do so will result, pursuant to N.J.A.C. 13:2-19.3(c), in the entry of a non-vult plea on your behalf and the Director upon certification by the Division may impose the penalty stated in this Notice of Charges without further notice.
