- **Watch Your Child for Potential Signs** of Abuse:
 - Changes in Use of Electronic Devices
 - Attempts to Conceal Online Activity
 - Withdrawal, Anger, Anxiety, Depression

CHILDREN

- **Don't Trust People You Don't Know**
- **Beware of Apps** Where People Conceal Their Identity
- **Do Not Reveal Personal Information** About Yourself
- **Be Careful of Sharing Photos and Videos**— Predators Can Identify and Locate You by Your School, Your Activities, or Other Background Information
- **Never Take or Share Inappropriate Photos or Videos**
