ABU RAZYEN)

The Grand Jurors of and for the State of New Jersey, upon their oaths, present that:

COUNT ONE

(Fraud in Casting Mail-in Vote - Third Degree)

ABU RAYZEN

between on or about January 1, 2020 and on or about May 12, 2020, in the City of Paterson, County of Passaic, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, did violate or did knowingly aid or abet another in violating one or more of the provisions of N.J.S.A. 19:63-1, et seq., that is, the said ABU RAYZEN, did serve as a messenger or bearer for more than three mail-in ballots or did knowingly take or attempt to take said mail-in ballots from one or more voters or other persons having custody of said mail-in ballots for the purpose of delivering the same to the Passaic County Board of Elections, or to a postal box or post office, without signing and printing his name on the outer envelope, in

violation of N.J.S.A 19:63-27, and contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 19:63-28 and N.J.S.A 19:63-16d(3), and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.

COUNT TWO

(Unauthorized Possession of Ballots - Third Degree)

ABU RAZYEN

between on or about January 1, 2020 and on or about May 12, 2020, in the City of Paterson, County of Passaic, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, did willfully have in his possession one or more official mail-in ballots issued to other voters without being authorized to have charge or possession thereof or did willfully have in his possession more than three (3) official mail-in ballots issued to other voters, that is, the said ABU RAZYEN had in his possession one or more official mail-in ballots issued to other voters without completing the bearer information required by N.J.S.A. 19:63-27 or had in his possession more than three official mail-in ballots issued to other voters, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 19:34-3, and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.
