



Law Enforcement Assisted Diversion

A collaboration between law enforcement officials and the public health community, to divert individuals who commit low-level offenses that are driven by substance use, mental illness, and/or poverty directly into a long-term system of care.

Individuals served are identified through collaboration with law enforcement and community-based referrals to connect people in crisis into services, including treatment and recovery opportunities.
