



# LEAD: Law Enforcement Assisted Diversion

A police officer has referred your case to a diversion program, instead of arrest. **Being part of LEAD is always your choice.** LEAD allows police, prosecutors, neighborhoods, and community supports and services to cooperate to ensure that individuals who commit repeated low-level offenses motivated by substance use, mental health, and/or poverty get help with addressing their problems.

**LEAD Care Coordinators work with participants to address immediate needs and develop an individual care plan to connect them with community support services, such as;**

- housing
- child care services
- family reconnection
- harm reduction
- applying for government benefits
- medications for opioid use disorder
- education & employment
- legal assistance
- reducing drug use
- mental health services
