• PFD Mandatory Wear during specific times and PWC passenger location requirements:

A discussion over the mandatory wear of Personal Floatation Devices (PFD) during specific times (I.E., Seasonal). Members conducted their own research. Requested more research to compare with neighboring States and their PFD regulations. NY has similar regulation to what NJ is attempting to move forward with. Members request more data from USCG stats and NASBLA stats.

• Passenger requirements on PWC:

Members agreed that passenger requirements should be further reviewed where no person shall be located between the operator and the steering controls if they do not possess a Boating Safety Certificate. Members agreed for a draft to be drawn up for this regulation and presented at next meeting.

 Board Members discussed the condition of members' terms. DAG Mehta advised they are on a 4 year term. Currently, all members' terms have expired and are in holdover status. The members serve at the Governor's pleasure.

• Commission members reviewed and approved the Sussex County Rowing Club Application for Boat Regulation Waiver.

VI. PUBLIC COMMENT

Members from the Marine Trades Association request that the mandatory wear of a PFD year round would have a negative response within the boating community and requested we look into mandatory wear during specific times of the year. They were advised it was never intended to be a year round regulation.
