### **Personalized Handgun Authorization Commission Public Session Meeting Minutes March 25, 2022**

The March 25, 2022 meeting of the New Jersey State Personalized Handgun Authorization Commission (PHAC, or “the Commission”) was conducted electronically via Microsoft Teams. Pursuant to the Open Public Meetings Act, notice was provided at least 48 hours before the scheduled meeting. Notice was filed with the Secretary of State, faxed to approved news publications including the Star Ledger, the Times of Trenton, the Bergen Record, the Courier Post, and the Press of Atlantic City, and also posted at the Hughes Justice Complex. The meeting began at 3 pm.

The Commission discussed OPMA compliance. It discussed New York and California standards for firearms; the concepts of firing and drop tests; and the overall question of electronic components’ ability to withstand abuse. It also discussed New Jersey State Police testing capacity, and the relationship between PHAC’s qualifying criteria and future industry innovation.

The Commission discussed possible next steps of reviewing law enforcement firearm standards and commercial firearm standards.
