5. Performance Standards and Qualifying Criteria

- Review of Commission's obligations, deadline, and prior discussions.
- Discuss inclusion of "reliability standards generally used in the industry for other commercially available handguns" *See* C.2C:58-2.8(c)(4). Chair request for members or public to identify any to discuss for inclusion by next meeting (June 9).
- Discuss potential additional performance standards or qualifying criteria. Chair request for members or public to propose additional standards or criteria by next meeting (June 9).

6. Testing Requirements for Mandatory Standards

- Three mandatory standards related to personalization technology:
 - "(1) the handgun shall be reasonably resistant to being fired by anyone other than the handgun's authorized user"
 - "(2) the personalized technology shall be incorporated into the design of the personalized handgun and shall be a permanent, irremovable part of the handgun and any device or object necessary for the authorized user to fire the handgun"
 - "(3) the personalized handgun shall not be manufactured so as to permit the personalized characteristics of the handgun to be readily deactivated"
- Commission is to "formulate" testing requirements / protocols for each standard.
