For purposes of "The Simulcasting Racing Act", the New Jersey Racing Commission will define races of "national interest" in the following manner:

**A. In the Case of Running Races**


1. A race will be presumed to be of national interest if it is classified a Grade I stake or part of the Breeders Cup series.

2. The Commission may classify other races as "a race of national interest" on a case-by-case basis. The in-state receiving track shall have the burden of convincing the Commission that such race is of "national interest."

**B. In the Case of Harness Races**

1. A race will be presumed to be of national interest if it is part of the Breeders Crown series or the Triple Crown of Trotting or Pacing, or a race with a purse value of at least \$100,000 excluding Sire Stakes events in any jurisdiction.

2. The Commission may classify other races as "a race of national interest" on a case-by-case basis. The in-state receiving track shall have the burden of convincing the Commission that such a race is of "national interest."
