Attention all Veterinarians and Trainers

All Veterinarians and/or Trainers are required to immediately report to the New Jersey Racing Commission Veterinarians, any horse(s) under their care with high fevers, enlarged lymph nodes, neurological signs or any unusual illness. Additionally, all horses that are shipped out for suspected infectious disease must also be reported. This Directive shall apply to all locations under the jurisdiction of the New Jersey Racing Commission.

Any person(s) found in violation of this Directive will be subject to penalties as contained in and authorized by the Administrative Code.
