**Certification of Microstamping Technology Viability
Pursuant to L. 2022, c. 57, N.J.S.A. 2C:58-2.13 to -2.15**

Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 2C:58-2.13(b)(2), the Attorney General “shall complete an investigation concerning the technological viability of microstamping-enabled firearms.” Following the conclusion of the investigation, “the Attorney General shall certify whether viable microstamping-enabled technology exists.” N.J.S.A. 2C:58-2.13(b)(2).

The viability investigation required by N.J.S.A. 2C:58-2.13(b)(2) is now complete. The factual findings of that investigation are documented in a report issued on February 28, 2024, which is publicly available on the Office of the Attorney General’s website at https://www.nj.gov/oag/safe/downloads/2024-0227_Microstamping-Viability-Report-and-Appendices.pdf. Based on those findings, I hereby certify that viable microstamping-enabled technology exists.
