## **Your Vote is Your Voice**



Election Day is Tuesday, Nov. 7. All 120 seats in the New Jersey Legislature are up for election this year, and there is still time to make your voice heard. If you are registered to vote and have not yet returned a mail-in ballot, you have three possible ways to vote.

- --- Vote-by-mail ballots must be completed and...
- Postmarked and mailed; OR
- •Placed in a secure ballot drop box; OR
- •Delivered to the Board of Elections in your county...
- ...BEFORE 8 p.m. on Tuesday, Nov. 7.
- —In-person, early voting is available through this Sunday, Nov. 5.
- —You may vote at your polling location on Tuesday, Nov. 7.

Nursing homes are required to help you exercise your right to vote. If you have concerns about being able to vote, call 1-877-582-6995.
