At the commencement of the meeting, Chair Hennessy-Shotter, pursuant to Section 5 of the Open Public Meetings Act, entered this announcement into the minutes of the meeting:

Adequate notice has been provided by the dissemination of a written "Annual Notice of Meeting." On December 18, 2025 a copy of such notice was:

- (a) prominently posted in a public place at the offices of the Public Employment Relations Commission;
- (b) e-mailed to the business offices of the Trenton Times and the Courier Post;
- (c) e-mailed to the Secretary of State for filing; and
- (d) posted on the agency's website

In March of 2026 a link to PERC's webpage was added to the Department of State Legal Notices Listings webpage as directed by personnel from the office of the Secretary of State.

Furthermore on June 17, 2026, copies of an additional written "Amended Annual Notice of Regularly Scheduled Meeting for

June 17, 2026" were posted and emailed in a similar manner.

The first item for consideration was the minutes of the May 28, 2026 meeting. Commissioner Davey moved the minutes and Commissioner Eaton seconded the motion. The motion to adopt the minutes was unanimously approved (Chair Hennessy-Shotter, Commissioners Davey, Eaton, Hines and Papero).

The Chair advised the Commissioners that a lack of quorum due to individual conflicts and the vacancy in a management position prohibited the Commission from considering a scope of negotiations matter between the Township of Monroe and PBA Local 255A this month. It is an indefinite quorum issue and the parties have been notified.

The General Counsel discussed Alex Rosetti v. Ramapo-Indian Hills Reg. High School Bd. of Ed., 2026 NJ LEXIS 560 (June 11, 2026) and its implications for State employees and officials.

The first case for consideration was South Orange-Maplewood Board of Education and South Orange-Maplewood Education Association, Docket No. SN-2026-019. Commissioner Eaton moved the draft decision and Commissioner Davey seconded the motion. The motion to adopt the draft decision was unanimously approved (Chair Hennessy-Shotter, Commissioners Davey, Eaton, Hines and Papero).

The next case for consideration was Mount Laurel Board of Education and Mount Laurel Education Association, Docket No. SN-2026-026. Commissioner Hines moved the draft decision and Commissioner Eaton seconded the motion. The motion to adopt the draft decision was unanimously approved (Chair Hennessy-Shotter, Commissioners Davey, Eaton, Hines and Papero).

The Chair asked for a motion to adjourn the meeting. Commissioner Davey made a motion to adjourn the meeting and Commissioner Hines seconded the motion. The motion was unanimously approved (Chair Hennessy-Shotter, Commissioners Davey, Eaton, Hines, and Papero). The meeting was then adjourned.
