## **Commission Cases**

Oral argument has been scheduled for December 2 in <u>Middlesex Cty. Sheriff and Joseph Kasha and Steven Eckel</u>, P.E.R.C. No. 2003-4, 28 <u>NJPER</u> 308 (¶33115 2002), app. pending, App. Div. Dkt. No. A-000057-02T2. The Commission held that the employer committed an unfair practice when it transferred a sheriff's officer in retaliation for his protected activity on behalf of the FOP.

Oral argument had been scheduled for November 19 in <u>City of Trenton and Trenton</u> <u>Superior Officers Ass'n</u>, described in my monthly report. But the Court has granted a motion to postpone argument because of an attorney's illness.

Passaic PBA Local No. 14 is seeking to have Passaic City held in contempt of a court order enforcing an interim relief decision issued by a Commission designee, I.R. No. 2004-2, 29 NJPER 310 (¶96 2003), enforced L-3673-03. An Order to Show Cause has been issued with a return date of November 9.
