SYNOPSIS

The Chair of the Public Employment Relations Commission and the Merit System Board entered a joint order consolidating an unfair practice charge filed with the Commission and several disciplinary appeals filed with the Merit System Board. The consolidated case will be heard by an Administrative Law Judge. The Judge's initial decision and the record will be forwarded to the Commission first to determine whether the personnel actions were motivated by hostility towards activity protected by the Employer-Employee Relations Act. The case will then be transferred to the Merit System Board to determine whether the employer had legitimate business reasons for the personnel actions and whether they were otherwise warranted under Merit System law. If necessary, the case will then be returned to the Commission for the issuance of any specialized relief.
