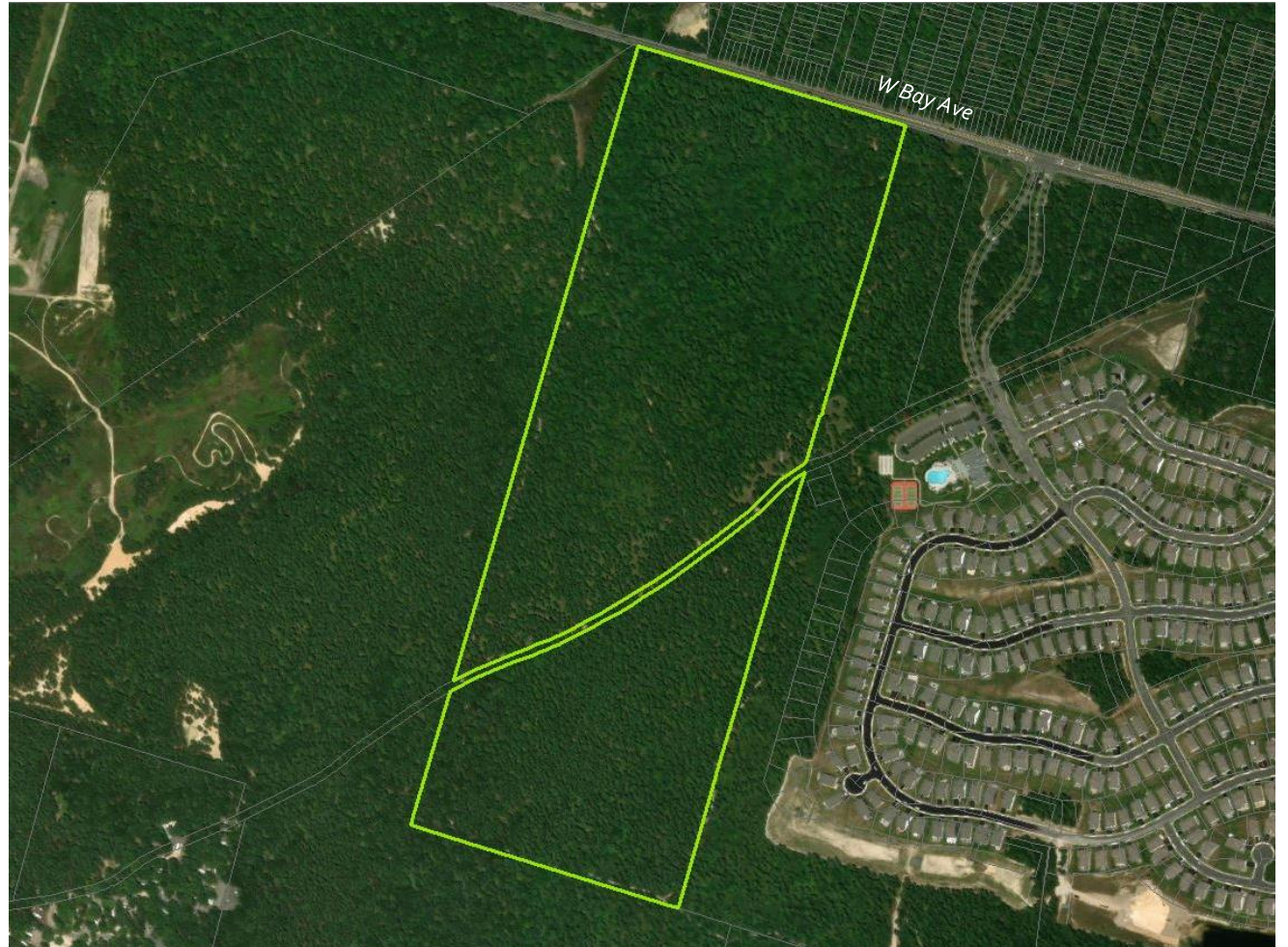

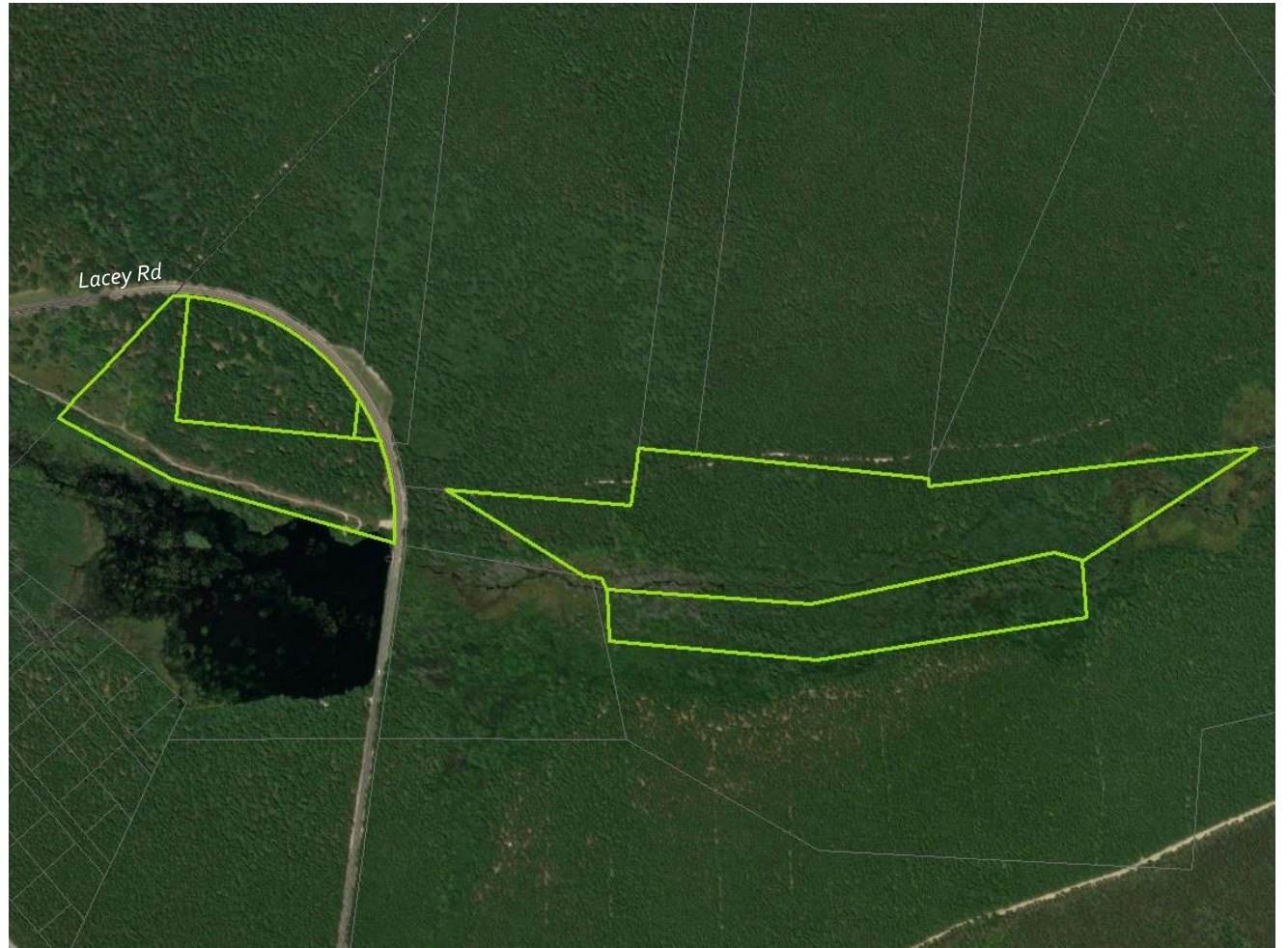

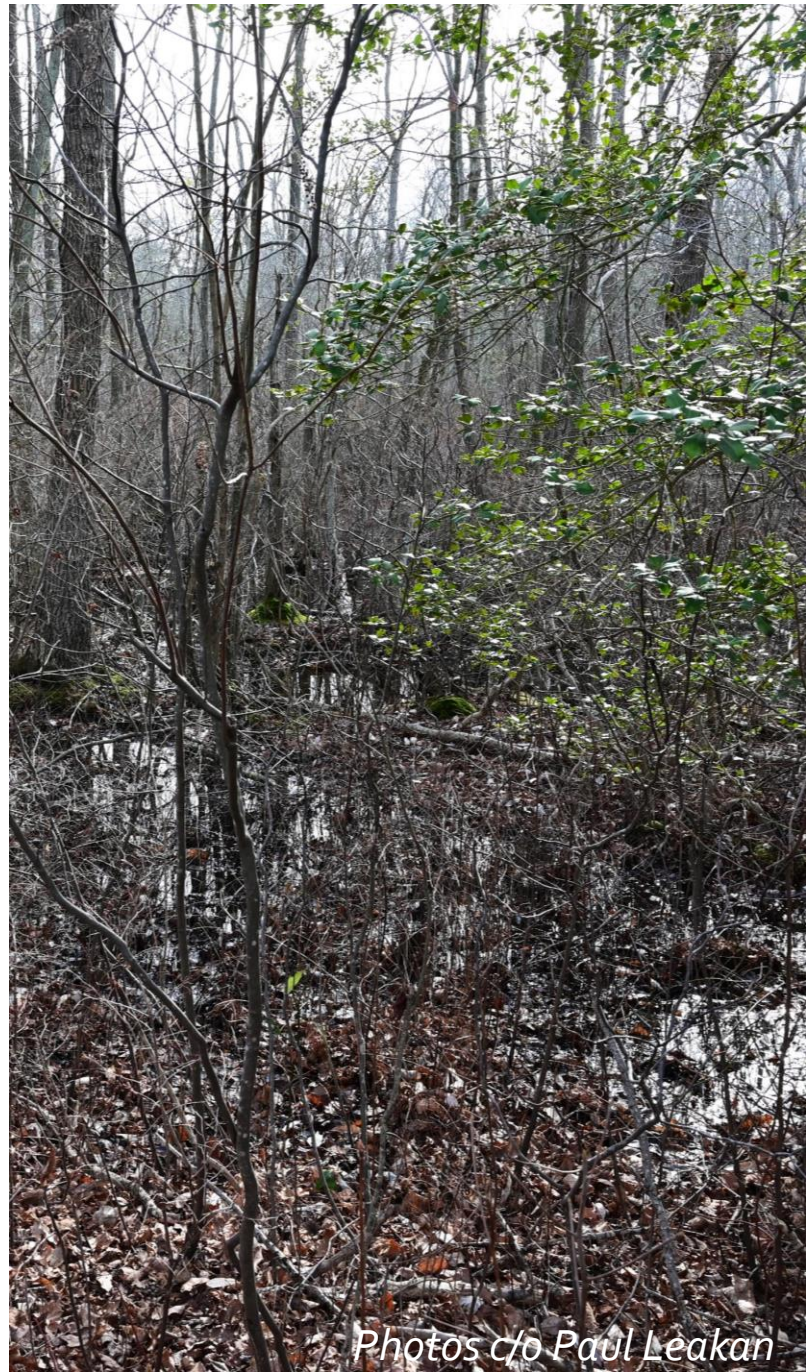

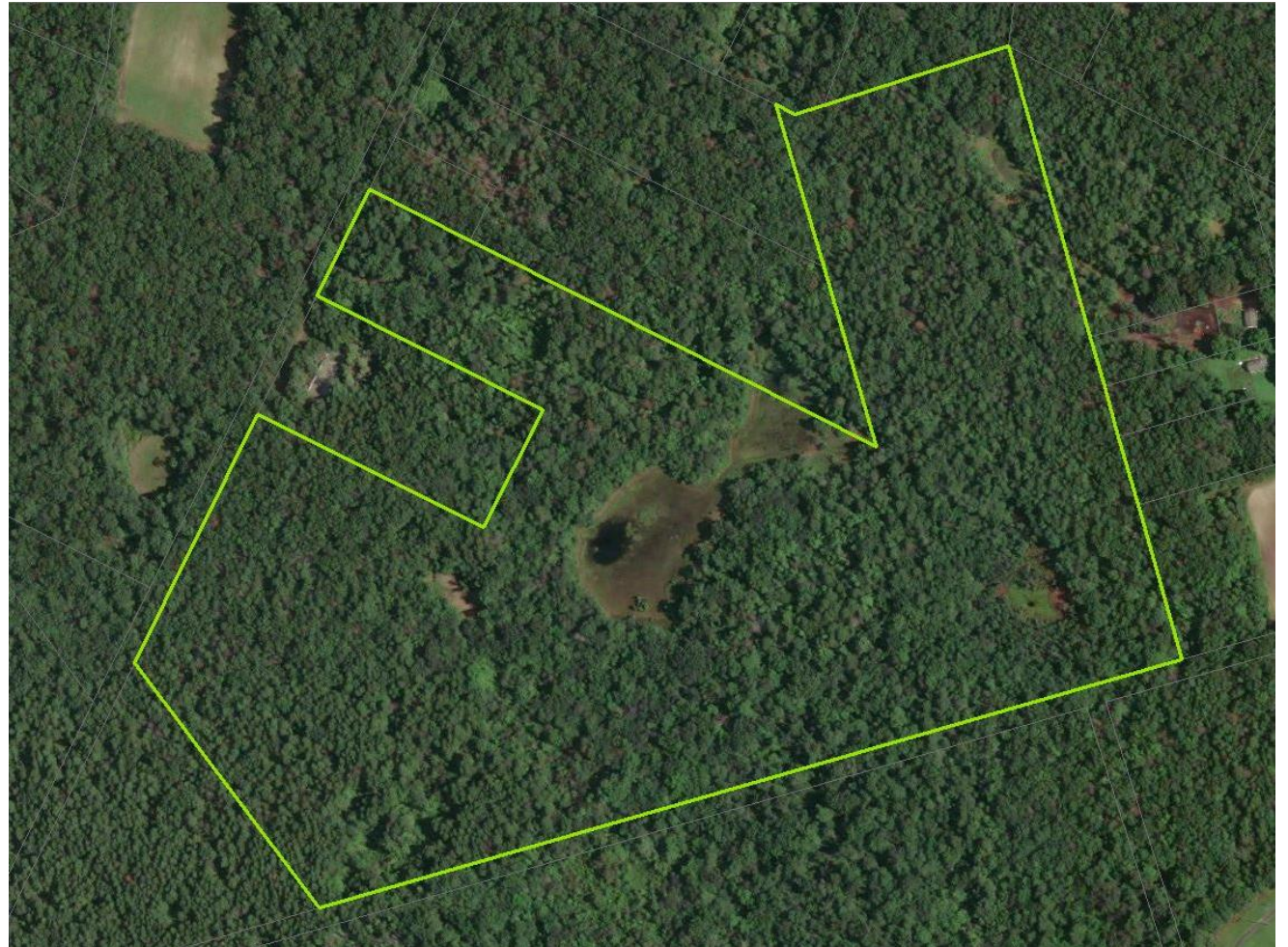

# Key Takeaways

- Forested sites are better preserved when contiguous with other forest and/or farther from roads and development
- Variety of benefits from land preservation
- Oldest PCF-funded sites still well preserved
