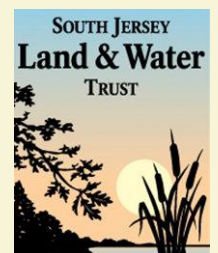


STREAM SCHOOL

This two day intensive classroom and field workshop will introduce participants to basic stream ecology and water quality monitoring techniques to prepare them for future volunteer monitoring at their local stream.

Attendees will learn how to collect and identify benthic macroinvertebrates, a key indicator species used to detect overall stream health. Visual, physical, and habitat monitoring methods will also be taught, with ample time for practice along the stream.

- Bring your own lunch.
- Participants should dress for outdoor exploration, rain or shine.
- Bring a pair of waders or tall knee boots.
- Children under the age of 18 must participate with a parent or guardian. No children under the age of 14 are permitted.
