NOTICE REGARDING THE INSTALLATION DEADLINE FOR SPECIFIC ALTERNATE DESIGN TREATMENT SYSTEMS IN THE PINELANDS AREA

Please take notice that **August 5, 2018** is the last day to begin the installation of a BioBarrier, Busse GT, Hoot ANR or SeptiTech alternate design septic system in the Pinelands Area pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:50-10.22(a)4. Although the Commission has formally proposed amendments to the Comprehensive Management Plan to eliminate this installation deadline, the amendments are not expected to be adopted and in effect until the end of 2018.

Installations of the BioBarrier, Busse GT, Hoot ANR and SeptiTech technologies that are begun prior to August 5, 2018 may proceed uninterrupted after the August 5, 2018 deadline.

Installations of the Amphidrome, Bioclere and FAST treatment technologies are unaffected by the August 5, 2018 installation deadline as these technologies have been permanently approved for use and are no longer participating in the Commission's pilot program.
