

PVSC Contract No. B203 (NJEIT Project No. S340689-49) for Construction of Perimeter Floodwall (B041), Stormwater Pumping Stations (B042), and Stormwater Collection System (B043), Newark, NJ 07105 - \$225,900,000.00 is being financed in part with funds provided by the New Jersey Water Bank (NJWB) and with disaster relief funds from the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA). The NJWB is a State Revolving Fund program jointly administered by the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) and the New Jersey Infrastructure Bank (Infrastructure Bank) and uses a combination of funds provided by the United States Environmental Protection Agency, the DEP, and the Infrastructure Bank to provide very low interest loans to borrowers for environmental infrastructure projects.

This project will provide water quality benefits through providing Resilient Infrastructure for residents and businesses in PVSC's service district within Bergen, Essex, Hudson, Passaic and Union Counties.

State Revolving Fund programs around the nation provide states and communities the resources necessary to maintain and improve the infrastructure protecting our valuable water resources nationwide.
