



Construction of upgrades and improvements to Project No. S340689-44, Contract No. B103A, Wallington Pump Station Rehabilitation Project, Passaic Valley Sewerage Commission, Borough of Wallington, Bergen County, New Jersey, \$19,993,850.00 (\$23,110,000.00) were financed by the New Jersey Water Bank (NJWB). The NJWB is a State Revolving Fund program jointly administered by the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) and the New Jersey Infrastructure Bank (Infrastructure Bank) and uses a combination of funds provided by the United States Environmental Protection Agency, the DEP, and the Infrastructure Bank to provide very low interest loans to borrowers for environmental infrastructure projects.

This project will provide water quality benefits related to the replacement, rehabilitation, and/or modernization of the entire pumping station's civil, mechanical, structural, electrical, instrumentation, and HVAC systems for residents and businesses in the service area of the Wallington Pump Station, which includes Wallington, and Garfield as well as portions of Passaic, Rutherford, East Rutherford, Saddle Brook, and Elmwood Park (total population of 53,000 people).

State Revolving Fund programs around the nation provide states and communities the resources necessary to maintain and improve the infrastructure protecting our valuable water resources nationwide.
